Registration Information

1. Courses are listed for the grade level the student is **entering** in September 2018.
2. Select the courses in which you would like to enroll your child. Course enrollments have limits and will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis. We will do our best to accommodate all selections.
3. Session 1 courses run for 9 days and **cost \$87.00 each.**
Session 2 courses run for 10 days and **cost \$97.00 each.**
Kindergarten courses run for 19 days and **cost \$184.00 each.**
Sibling Discount-There is a 10% discount for **each** sibling taking **2 or more courses.**
