

The Island Trees School District offers the NY State Driver Education Program to resident students who are 16 years old at the start of the program and who possess a valid NYS Learner's Permit.

The programs are offered three times a year, in the fall, spring and summer. Applications for our mailing list are sent out to the entire 10<sup>th</sup> grade class (both public and private school students) each year. It is your responsibility to return this form with the associated fee in order to receive further mailings about future classes. Before signing up for the Drivers Ed Program make sure sports, clubs, or other activities will not prohibit you from attending the mandatory classes. Only three sessions can be made up by the end of each session.

Based on the Board of Education Policy students may be denied on the basis of disciplinary standing. In addition, students must meet the school attendance requirement of 85% in each class.
