If a threat had been made against a student or our school, the Nassau County Police Department would have been contacted immediately. Additionally if a credible threat was made against a student or our school, all families would have been notified.

As with the families who reached out to me directly, I would always encourage you to contact me directly with any questions or concerns you may have—even on weekends. I will do all in my power to clarify any questions you may have and receive additional information that you may wish to share.

Like you, the safety of your children is the highest priority. I look forward to continuing to work with you to support our kids and ensure that our school environment promotes safety, respect and responsibility.
